Workforce Solutions for Employers

The Lancaster County Workforce Development Board recently updated local policy to allow and encourage apprenticeship support in the form of work-based learning and supportive services for career-seekers and employers. They have prioritized apprenticeship in the request for proposal processes when looking to contract with new training and service providers. Pre-Apprenticeship Programs

Pre-Apprenticeship services and programs are designed to prepare individuals to enter and succeed in Registered Apprenticeship Programs. Program elements vary depending on the industry; existing models are designed for high school students, returning citizens, or adults who are changing careers. Many programs offer industry recognized credentials.



PA CareerLink® Centers

PA CareerLink® Centers provide employment programs and services such as case management and supportive services for youth ages 16-24, adults, dislocated workers, returning citizens, and those affected by Trade. Career-seekers who are interested in gaining skills for a new career or upskilling for their next career move can enter into Vocational Skills Training that align perfectly with Registered Apprenticeship Programs.



Educational Partners

Local high schools, community colleges, and career & technical centers are focused on school to career opportunities and preparation more and more. Many offer Pre-Apprenticeship programs that align with Registered Apprenticeships and some have staff dedicated to supporting and coaching students on finding such opportunities.



The Apprenticeship and Training Office (ATO) within the PA Department of Labor & Industry is responsible for guiding and promoting the expansion of apprenticeship programs across the state.
